Irrigation Information

In order to to retain our water reserves throughout the year, the district has implemented a Water Sustainability Plan. We must all resist the urge to over-water our lawns when we see a little stress in our grass. If grass needs replacement, consider holding off until June or July, during the rainy season.

The State has established Phase II water Restrictions all year-round. This limits irrigation to two days a week. Watering just two days a week, evenly spaced is really all our landscape requires, save for Bermuda grass and some ornamental plants. Duration trumps frequency. If we must apply more water to our landscape it is most efficient to add time to our two watering days, rather than add days to our watering schedule. This practice, over time, promotes a deep root system, enabling plants and grasses to thrive throughout the year, even in the dry season.

The current irrigation schedules are:

- * ODD number addresses may water on Wednesday & Saturday 4am - 8am
- * EVEN number addresses may water on Thursday & Sunday 4am - 8am

The irrigation systems will be shut down as follows:

Thursday 4pm until Friday 8am

Saturday 10am until 4pm

Sunday 10am until 4pm
